Raising Readers FAQs

Q. How soon will I receive my book\ tote order?

A. Orders will arrive in **3-5 business days**. (Even if you generally receive orders more quickly, you should not depend on it. Don't get caught short!)

Q. What should I do if there's a problem with my order?

A. Call us at 1-800-397-3263 so we can correct the problem quickly.

Q. Are supply orders shipped with book\ tote orders?

A. No. Supply orders are shipped separately on a weekly basis.
